## Studies from Chang-Gung University provide new data on Cord Blood Cord Blood

2007 SEP 20 - (NewsRx.com) -- "This report exemplified a success of unrelated CBT in a two-month-old boy with Wiskott-Aldrich Syndrome. Umbilical cord blood was chosen as the stem-cell source because of its immediate availability and reduced tendency to cause GVHD," scientists in Taiwan report.

"The conditioning regimen was cyclophosphamide, busulfan, and antithymocyte globulin. GVHD prophylaxis consisted of cyclosporin and methylprednisolone. The patient received an HLA 1-locus-mismatched cord blood unit, and the total number of infused nucleated cells was  $11.14 \times 10^7$ /kg. Neutrophil engraftment was achieved on day + 11, and a platelet count greater than  $50 \times 10^9$ /L was achieved on day + 71. He is currently alive and doing well at nine months post-transplant and free of any bleeding episodes," wrote T.H. Jaing and colleagues, Chang-Gung University.

The researchers concluded: "This case suggests that unrelated donor CBT may be safe and technically feasible, even in early infancy, when an appropriately matched related or unrelated donor is unavailable."

Jaing and colleagues published their study in *Pediatric Transplantation* (Early transplantation of unrelated cord blood in a two-month-old infant with Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome. *Pediatric Transplantation*, 2007;11(5):557-559).
